Parliamentary Track at the global IGF 2025

- Official Parliamentary Track invitation letters sent out by the IPU and available in English, French and Spanish on the IGF and IPU website
- Programme development based on input received from Members of Parliament
 - Dedicated, open Parliamentary Track sessions on 23 and 24 June
 - > Visit of the Norwegian Parliament followed by a reception on 23 June
 - Further integrating Members of Parliaments in other IGF sessions
- Six (6) sessions around the topics of:
 - > Freedom of Expression, mis- and disinformation and online harms
- > Outcomes: the IGF Parliamentary Track output document

Plans for 2025

- Further collaborate with the joint UNDP-IPU initiative to align Parliamentary initiatives among the UN system, Parliamentary Associations and partners of the digital ecosystem (curate a repository and share reports, upcoming events).
 - Development of an AI Chatbot for Parliaments to support with digital policies.
- Create a toolbox for National and Regional IGF initiatives to launch Parliamentary activities and further support those NRIs already implementing Parliamentary Tracks
- Create a regular Newsletter for the IGF network of Parliamentarians
