b) The Process:

In representation of the 2017 OC, the NGO Hiperderecho organized an Invitation Only Meeting in September (2019) with some of the

other 2017 OC members (Red Científica Peruana and D&D Internacional) and invited three new organizations that showed interest to be part of the new OC (CGI-USMP, Ingenio Learning and SEGDI). After the first call it was decided to establish a new Organization Committee and the leadership was given to the NGO Hiperderecho both in logistic and the agenda making.

The agenda for this edition were defined based on private consultations and public polls conducted between September and November of 2019. At the end of consultation period, the OC drafted the agenda, which final version was defined on November. Speakers were invited using the inputs and recommendation of OC members, but also through the registration form the public was invited to propose speakers for the topics of the agenda.






